It enables organizations to measure baseline water performance, set measurable, local and contextually relevant targets, demonstrate water stewardship and resiliency practices, and monitor progress year over year.

Who is Eligible?

SCS Certification for Water Stewardship is applicable to organizations of all sizes worldwide, across various industries, that seek to demonstrate their commitment to effective water stewardship and resiliency practices at a site level.

Organizations can go above and beyond base level certification by achieving one or more of the "Trailblazer" categories outlined in the standard. These include:

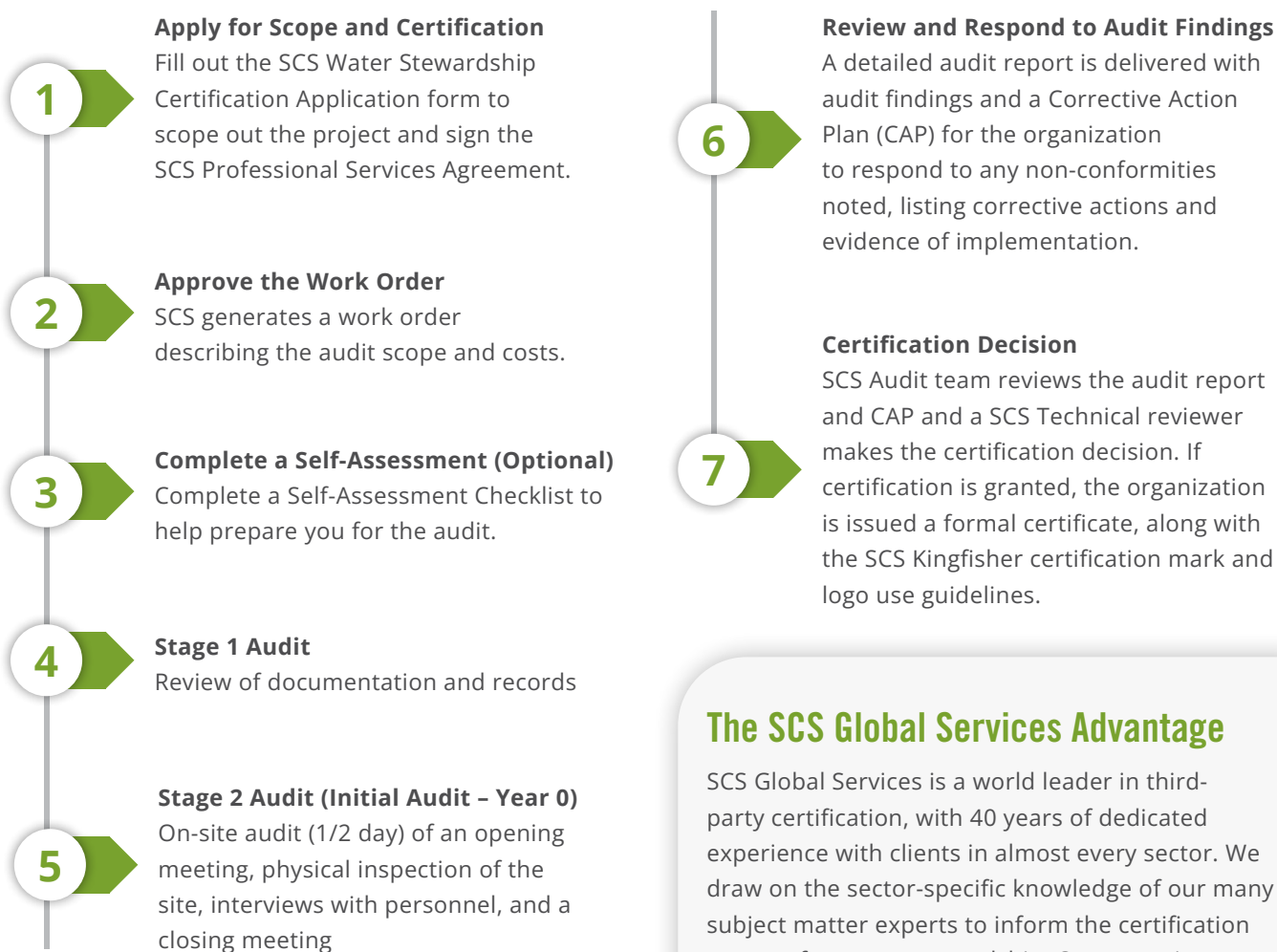
